Personal, Social & Emotional Development

• We will learn to resolve our own minor conflict issues if and when they occur – We will do this by listening to each other to find a fair solution.

• We will continue to develop our confidence in speaking to others about own interests and opinions.

• We will continue to learn how to work in a group by understanding and following the rules.

Communication & Language

- We will continue to develop our listening skills in a range of situations.
- We will listen to stories and be able to discuss the events with our peers by asking and answering questions.
- •We will continue to develop our skills in following instructions that involve several ideas or actions.
- •We will work with our talk partners to confidently develop our speaking and listening skills.
- •We will learn past, present and future forms accurately when talking about events.

<u>Literacy</u>

- We will continue to use our phonic knowledge to read and decode words accurately.
- We will learn to read unfamiliar words.
- •We will continue to use our phonic knowledge to write words and learn to spell some words correctly.
- We will learn to write in a variety of ways including list making and instruction writing.
- •We will begin to read with expression during our guided reading session.
- We will learn to use computers and books to find information.

<u>Physical</u> Development

• We will be able to create various dance routines – being able to skip and hop confidently in time to music.

•We will continue to be able to write on lines and control letter size using our preferred hand.

Mathematics

• We will continue to estimate amounts of objects and look at different properties including size, weight and capacity.

• We will be able to confidently explore one more and one less of a given number up to 20.

• We will begin to learn to count in 2s and 10s and to be able to solve number problems involving sharing.

• We will practise subtraction by counting backwards on the number line.

• We will use a range of technology to support our learning e.g. Cameras, headphones, Ipads and computers.
