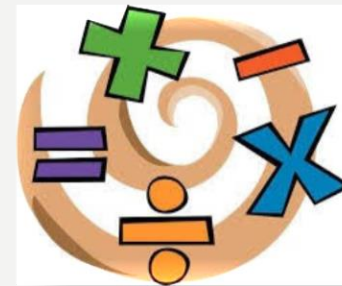

# MATHS

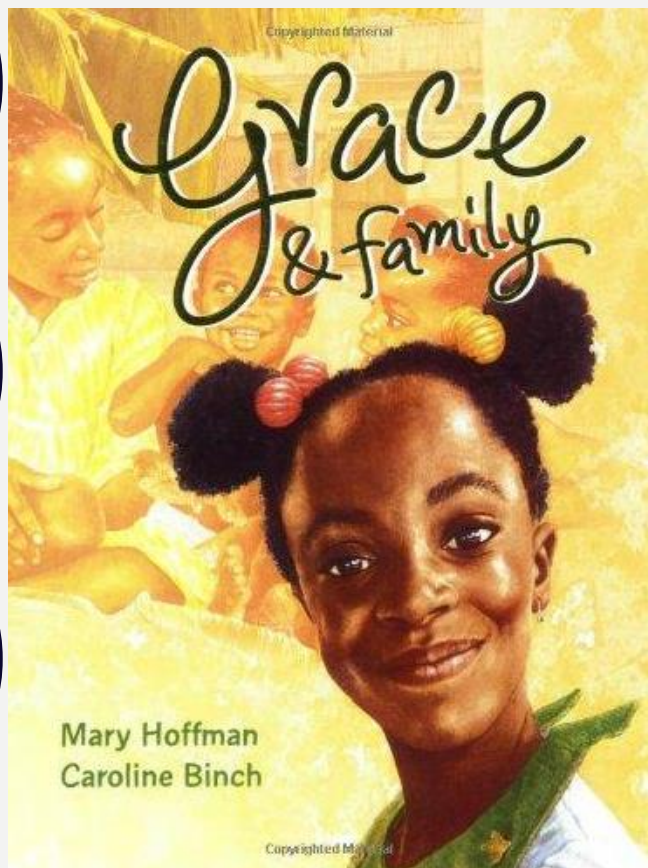
This half term we will cover:

- Using directional language to describe position and direction.
- We will also be doing a lot of revision on the basics, e.g. addition, subtraction, division and multiplication.



# ENGLISH

This half term we will be reading 'Grace and Family' by Mary Hoffman.



Within this text we will focus on:

- Generating ideas from a photo stimulus
- Recording key ideas and planning
- Features of letter writing
- Character descriptions
- Letter planning and sequencing
- Proof-reading to check for spelling errors and missing punctuation
- Using simple organisation devices when writing for a different purpose
- Form different types of sentences: statement, exclamation, question and command using the correct punctuation
- Use horizontal and diagonal strokes to join letters

# Other subjects

## **PE:**

### **Balance**

## **Religious Education:**

The children will be learning about what makes Jewish people believe they have a special relationship with **God** and understand the roles of **Abraham** and **Moses** in this.
