Computing is categorised into 3 areas, which are Digital Literacy and E-Safety, Computer Science and Information Technology.

Digital Literacy & E-Safety

- All children are responsible, competent, confident and creative users of information and communication technology.
- **Computer Science**
- All children can understand and apply the fundamental principles and concepts of computer science, including abstraction, logic, algorithms and data representation.
- All children can analyse problems in computational terms, and have repeated practical experience of writing computer programs in order to solve such problems.
- **Information Technology and Digital Life Skills**
- All children can evaluate and apply information technology, including new or unfamiliar technologies, analytically to solve problems.

Children will use Purple Mash within their computing lessons and Autumn 1 will focus on Online Safety.
