Foundation Stage

Two reading books are sent home on a weekly basis to read with your child - asking questions, discussing characters, the story and encouraging your child to make predictions about what happens next.

Topic related homework/tasks are also sent home if it is felt that it will enhance your child's learning.

Lower School (Years 1 – 3)

Homework is sent home once a week. Your child's class teacher will inform you of the day it is set each week.

Homework consists of weekly spelling to learn and a maths and English task. The tasks are a reinforcement of what is covered in class and your child should be able to complete these independently. The work is carefully differentiated to meet the needs of the children, however, at the end of each homework task, there may be an additional question or challenge. This is optional and is designed to extend your child's thinking. They may need support with the challenge task. In addition, please read with your child every day, discussing the plot, the characters, use of language and encouraging your child to make predictions.

Upper School (Years 4 – 6)

Homework is set twice a week on a Monday (due in on Thursday) and a Thursday (due in Monday). Maths, English, Science, History and Geography is covered. Similar to Lower Phase, the tasks are reinforcement of work covered in class and your child should be able to complete the work independently. However, some research may be set. It is strongly recommended that your child attempts the challenge task, as this is designed to extend his/her thinking, however, some support may be required. Weekly spellings are also set and tested. In addition, please read with your child every day, discussing the plot, the characters, use of language and encourage your child to infer meaning from the text.
