



# Year 5 Curriculum Map

### English

In year 5, we will be reading the adventures of Odysseus, making cross-curricular links to our history topic about the Ancient Greeks. Our learning will be supported with child led writing and various discussion based activities. After this text, we shall be covering the National Curriculum grammar and writing objectives through specific genres.

#### Maths

Hermitage

During Autumn 1, our focus will be on place value, addition and subtraction. In addition, we will be doing work on reasoning, problem solving and using mental math tests.

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#### Science

• The science topic this term is 'Properties and changes of materials'. We will look at comparing and grouping materials based on their properties as well investigating which solids dissolve.

#### History

 This term we shall be looking at the Ancient Greeks. Amongst other areas, we will focus on the differences of the lives of men, women and children and the Olympic games.

### Art

We will be looking at the artist Dali and using the medium of paint.

### Computing

This half term the unit is called 'We are game developers'. The children will plan their own simple computer games on scratch.
