



Year 5 Curriculum Map

English

We shall be using the book: Comic by Frank Cottrell Boyce. During the topic we'll be exploring the characters and the journey Liam, the main character, goes on.

During the spring term we shall be focussing on:

Maths

Hermitage

- Continuing our work on fractions: adding and subtracting and multiplying fractions with different denominators. Using mixed numbers to perform the same operations.
- Solve problems involving numbers up to three decimal places.
- Multiply and divide whole numbers and those involving decimals by 10, 100 and 1000.
- Write percentages as a decimal and as a fraction with the denominator as 100; solve percentage problems.

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Science

The science topic this term is 'Earth & Space'. We will be looking at the movements of the Earth, the Moon phases and how the Sun appears to move across the sky.
