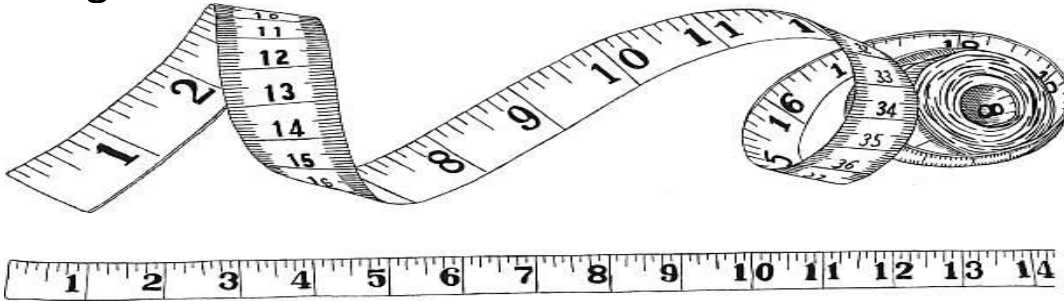


Hermitage

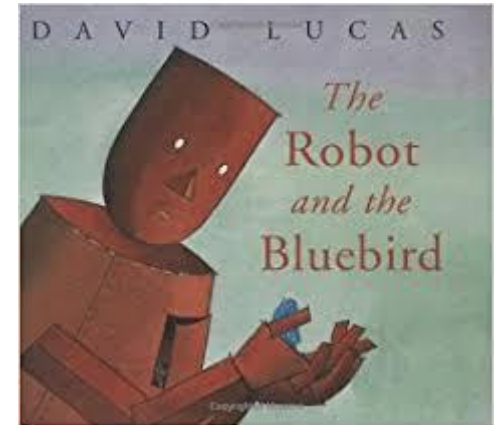


English

- Identifying and understanding what makes up a sentence (nouns, verbs and adjectives).
- Continuing to write sentences correctly using full stops, capital letters and finger spaces with use of new vocabulary.
- Continuing to practise and use cursive handwriting.
- Begin to use and apply spelling rules in our writing (ex. Suffixes: er, est, ing).
- Continuing weekly spelling tests.
