Personal, Social & Emotional Development

- We will develop our ability to ask appropriate questions.
- We will continue to develop our confidence in speaking to others about own interests and opinions.
- We will continue to develop an understanding of our own and others feelings through circle times and role play.

Communication & Language

- We will continue to develop our listening skills in a range of situations.
- We will listen to stories and learn to respond to what we hear with relevant comments, extending our language of first, second, third etc...
- We are able to follow stories without pictures or props.
- We will develop our skills in following instructions that involve several ideas or actions.
- We will learn to answer 'how' and 'why' questions.
- We will learn to express ourselves effectively using "because" to extend our ideas.
- We will learn past, present and future forms accurately when talking about events.

Literacy

- We will learn to use our phonic knowledge to read and decode words accurately.
- We will learn to read unfamiliar words.
- We will extend our vocabulary through different experiences within our environment and various books.
- We will continue to use our phonic knowledge to write words and learn to spell some words correctly.
- We will learn to write common irregular words, and labels and captions.
- We will begin to read words and simple sentences.
- We will learn to use computers and books to find information.

Physical Development

- We will develop our understanding of the importance of a healthy diet.
- We will develop our confidence in investigating different ways of travelling and moving around our environment safely.
- We will record different ways of how we can travel in our setting.

- We will focus on the concepts of doubling and halving.
- We will continue to practice one more and one less of a given number.
- We will continue our learning on 2D and 3D shapes, naming shapes correctly and talking about their properties.
- We will begin to learn to count in 2s.
- We will continue to order numbers from smallest to largest.

Understanding the World

- We will be looking closely at our environment focusing on seasonal changes, e.g. weather, animals, trees and plants.
- We will ask and answer questions about these changes.
- We will plant our own seeds.
- We will learn how to programme Bee-bots.



Expressive Arts & Design

- We will produce a still life drawing of a spring flower.
- We will manipulate materials to make a Spring display.
- We will learn to select appropriate tools and develop techniques to shape and assemble different materials.
- During role play activities we will continue to introduce a storyline or narrative.
