Summer 1

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English

- We shall be using the book: Floodlands. It is based on environmental changes. When England is flooded, the main character has to fight to survive as she is pitted against marauding gangs.

Maths

- During the summer term we shall be focussing on geometry, measurement, perimeter and area. We'll also be looking at: angles, shapes, converting units, prime numbers, and volume.

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Science

- We'll be looking at 'Properties of materials' and 'Living things'. We'll look at how mixtures are separated, can be reversed and made. With 'living things' we'll be looking at how plants reproduce.

History

- This term we shall be looking at the 'History of Uxbridge'. This includes the changes to the trains/underground, buildings and the history of our school. In addition, we will be focusing on changes in the High Street and change in shopping patterns.

Other Subjects

Art

We will be designing our own maquette and looking at sculptures.

Computing

We will be exploring internet safety through a range of different strategies and tasks.

PE

This half term the class shall be doing athletics and cricket and looking at health and fitness in PE.

RE

During RE we are learning about how Sikh's show commitment to god.
