- Using our empathy to care for the animals in our role play vet area.



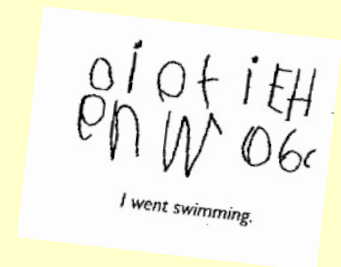
Physical Education

- We will continue to look at rhyming words and alliteration in our stories.
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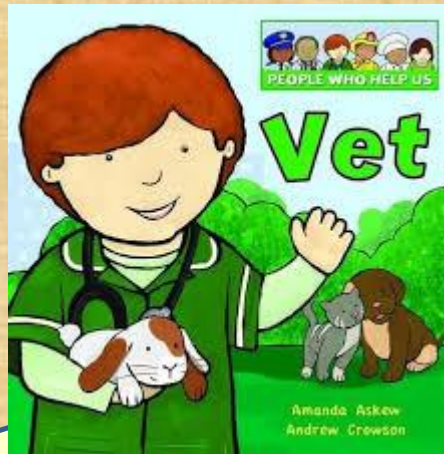


Adding using Numicon
